TASTING NOTES

Distinguished, Assertive, Opulent. The Prophecy Cabernet Sauvignon commands attention with its exceptional structure and savoury tannins. This is a complex, layered and clearly articulated red.

Decadent aromas of blackcurrant and tobacco transition effortlessly into a palate of warm oak and dark berries.

VITICULTURE

A true revelation, our Prophecy Collection showcases the results of our most exceptional fruit. Sourced from the highest quality vines and produced with the utmost attention to detail, Prophecy demonstrates Queensland's striking capacity for quality. As a result, these wines may not be seen every vintage.

We have crafted our 2019 Prophecy Cabernet Sauvignon from a select block grown by Davydd Westlake in the Ballandean district of Queensland's Granite Belt.

WINEMAKING

The hand-picked fruit for our 2019 Prophecy Cabernet Sauvignon was fermented on skins for 23 days before being racked off gross lees to maintain the vibrant primary fruit flavours.

To add to its structure and complexity, the Prophecy Cabernet Sauvignon was left on Malo lees during its 19 months maturation in a combination of new and seasoned French and American Oak Barriques.
